U.S. Government Submitting Completed 4-page Paper Procedures

I. Login to your CMT account

II. Editing your submission and updating your conflicts after you have submitted

- 1) In the Author Console, you will see a list of all your submissions.
- 2) Find the submission you want to change.
- 3) To make changes to a submission, click “Edit Submission” on the right side of your submission.



III. Uploading a new PDF document

You must delete your old file before uploading a new one. The system only allows one file.

- 1) To delete your previous file, select the X next to the previous submission file.




FILES

You can upload from 1 to 3 files. Maximum file size is 10 Mb. We accept doc, docx, pdf formats.

- 2) To upload your updated submission, you can either drag your file into the gray box or select the “Upload from computer” button. Ensure your final submission file is in PDF format under 10 Megabytes.
